Dear Parents & Families,

As we move towards the middle of the year, I would like to remind families of some of our important morning routines at school.

Classes commence each day at 9.00am. It is most important that the students are at school prior to 9.00am so that they can unpack their bag and get items such as books, reader folders, drink bottles and pencil cases ready for the day. Our doors open at 8.45am each day allowing 15 minutes for the students to do this and have some time to play. At 8.57 the music commences playing and the children move directly to their classrooms ready for learning time. If your child is late, this will disrupt the learning time of all the students so it is imperative that students are at school before the music commences.

The time from 8.45am – 9.00am is also an important time for the teachers to complete their preparations for the day and welcome their students as they arrive. It is also a time when they are 'on duty' so it's not a time where the teacher can adequately discuss your child's progress or personal issues with you. The teachers are more than happy to organise a time to chat with you over any particular needs of your child, just leave your details at the school office or through the app and they will get back to you when they are free.
