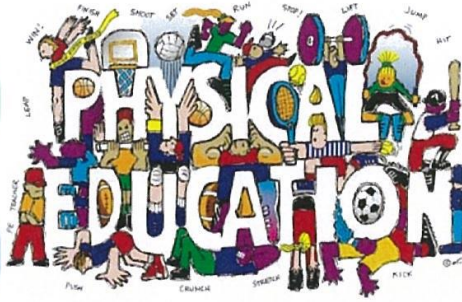

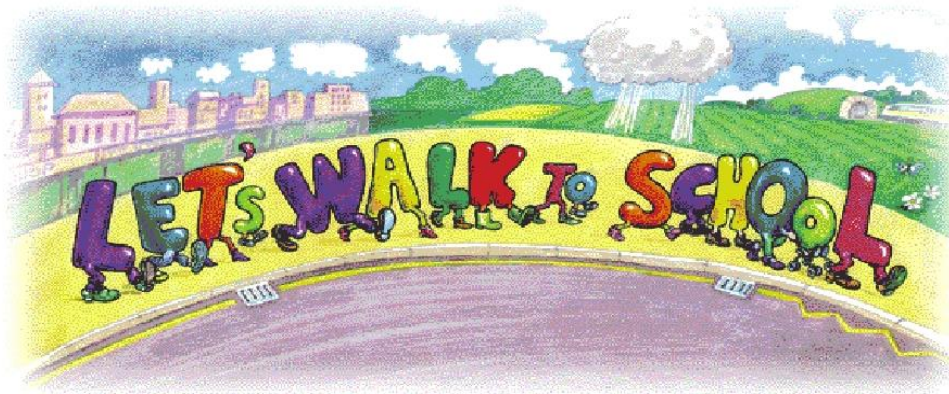

October Month of Mary: This year the Catholic Church is celebrating the Centennial Anniversary of the Last apparition of our Lady of Fatima in Portugal, so our Parish takes this opportunity to celebrate Mary in this month of October for four Saturday of Rosary: 7th, 14th, 21st and 28th at 5pm. We are putting a lot of effort into these dates and you are invited to participate. Marian apparitions were reported in 1917 by three shepherd children at the Cova da Iria, in Fatima, Portugal. The three children were Lucia Santos and her cousins Jacinta and Francisco Marto. The reported visions at Fatima gathered widespread attention, as numerous pilgrims began to visit the site. Today, the largest crowds gather on 13 May and 13 October, when up to a million pilgrims have attended to pray and witness processions of the statue of Our Lady of Fatima, both during the day and by the light of tens of thousands of candles at night.
