For a fast, simple and secure way to place your booklist orders visit website: **booklist.officecorporate.com.au**

Simply follow the below easy steps:

- 1. Select the student's relevant year level and click "view details."
- This will display *mandatory* booklist items for that year level.
 Simply click "add to cart". This will add all *mandatory* items to your cart.
 Please note: QTY of mandatory items is fixed and cannot be changed.
- 3. You will now have the option to add *recommended items* for that year level. Simply click **"add to cart"** to add these items individually. *QTY for recommended items can be adjusted to your requirement.*
- 4. Once you are happy with all items in your cart click "Proceed to Checkout."
- 5. **Checkout Details:** Enter student's name, parent's email address, delivery address & contact phone. Click **"continue."**
- 6. **Payment Information:** Enter your credit card details into our secure form.
- 7. Review Order Details: Once you have reviewed items click "place order."

You will receive an order confirmation to your nominated email address. An original tax invoice will be sent with goods.

Delivery:

All orders will be sent out via courier. A specific time of delivery cannot be requested. In the event that nobody is available to receive the delivery, the driver will attempt to find a safe place to leave your goods. Please note PO Boxes are not allowed.

Packaging & Handling: ORDER BEFORE 31ST DECEMBER 2017 AND SAVE \$9.95 ON PACKAGING AND HANDLING

All orders placed prior to 31 December 2017 will only have a \$6.95 Inc GST Packaging and Handling fee.

All orders placed after 31 December 2017 will incur a \$16.90 Inc GST Packaging and Handling fee.

Missing Items:

Claims must be addressed with Office Corporate no later than 7 days after you have received your goods.

Payment Methods:

Payment Methods available online are: Visa & Mastercard. Your card will be charged immediately at the time you place the order and a Tax Invoice will be sent out with the goods.

Product Substitution & Back Orders:

If a product is unavailable at the time of packing, the product may be substituted with a similar product of the same or greater value.

If a product is unavailable and cannot be substituted the product will be placed on back order. Backordered items will be sent to your initial order address free of charge once they are available.
