engineering and mathematics — in an interdisciplinary and applied approach. More recently we have been focussing on developing our Coding skills as we begin to introduce this into our curriculum.

As a part of this, we have been invited to participate in a Junior Girls Coding Workshop which looks at celebrating the involvement of young girls in STEM. Twenty girls selected from Prep – Year 2 will work with Sarah & Helen from Girl Geek Academy this Friday as part of this Federal funding initiative and The Australian newspaper will also be here to report on the event.
