A Prep 2019 Information Night will be held this Wednesday Evening, March 28, at 7.00pm. This night is for parents of children who will commence school in 2019 and would like to learn more about our school. Places are limited, so if your child is 4 year old Kinder please collect an Enrolment Form as soon as possible.

ST JOHN'S FIRST AID IN SCHOOLS

St John Ambulance will visit our school tomorrow to deliver free First Aid in Schools training to our students. Through the First Aid in Schools program, trained St John presenters lead students from Prep to Grade 6 through tailored sessions on the importance of First Aid and what to do in the event of an emergency. Our junior students learn about how to identify when there is an emergency, keeping themselves safe, and how to call for an ambulance. Senior students learn about delivering CPR and the things they can do to assist in an emergency.

Participating students will be given a special piece of homework for parents to take home and complete. We encourage you to "do your homework" and go online at www.stjohnvic.com.au/quiz to see how much you know about First Aid.


Book School Interviews Online



Reflection for Holy Week:

In Holy Week, we think about the passion, death and resurrection of Our Lord. We are not merely recalling historical events. We are not just re-enacting a pageant with no meaning. We are remembering and reflecting on these events in order that we may ourselves participate in the work of Christ. Our Lord was offering himself to God his father: offering His love which he expressed through obedience – an obedience which included the acceptance of death. At the same time, he was passing through death to life so that you and I might share in his risen life. We have to be involved in the offering of love which Christ made on the Cross. In the sacrifice of the Mass we are provided with that opportunity. Through the sacraments, especially the Eucharist, we receive the risen life of Christ, indeed in Holy Communion we receive the very author of that life. Our chief thought on Holy Thursday is the institution of the mass. On Good Friday we think of the offering Our Lord made of himself to his Heavenly Father. On Holy Saturday we think of that risen life in which we share. In a sense, every time the Mass is celebrated, Holy week is contained in its entirety.
