Dear Parents & Families,

Thank you to all the parents who dressed up their children for the Book Parade last Thursday as part of our celebration of Book Week. It was also great to see many parents come along to watch the parade. Some photos of the parade are included in today's newsletter.

LITERACY & NUMERACY WEEK

This year National Literacy and Numeracy Week is celebrated across Australian schools from Monday August 29 until Sunday September 4. It aims to raise the awareness and importance of literacy and numeracy at school and beyond. At school we are celebrating Literacy aspect of the week with writing a whole school story. All grades will be involved to write a jointly constructed piece of writing moving through the phases of the Writing Process. The Writing Process is what writers go through to construct a piece of writing. It consists of Planning, Composing, Recording, Revising, Editing and Publishing.

On Monday 29th August the Preps will plan and compose the story. This will be passed onto the Year 1/2 class on Tuesday 30th August, the 2/3 class on Wednesday 31st August and the 3/4 class on Thursday 1st September to complete the recording stage of the story. Finally on Friday 2nd September the Year 4/5/6 Learning Space will receive the writing to revise, edit and publish the writing piece.

Look out for the writing piece that will be published in next week's newsletter!

As part of our celebration of Numeracy, we have added a family quiz to this week's newsletter. There are only 4 questions, but they are designed to promote discussion at home between the parents and the children. Whilst they may be a little difficult for students in our junior classes, there are some aspects of each question that you can discuss with your

child. The activities are designed to be a fun way to engage in Maths with your child, and each correct entry will go into our prize draw which will be drawn at school Assembly next Monday, September 5.

INDOOR SOCCER CHAMPIONSHIPS

Last Friday, selected Year 3/4 girls and boys teams participated in the Reservoir Cup Indoor Soccer Championships. Both teams performed very well throughout the day against very tough opposition, with our girls team finishing 5th overall, and our boys team finishing 3rd. Congratulations to all players for their efforts and sportsmanship throughout the day. This Friday we have our Year 5/6 girls and boys teams representing OLW.

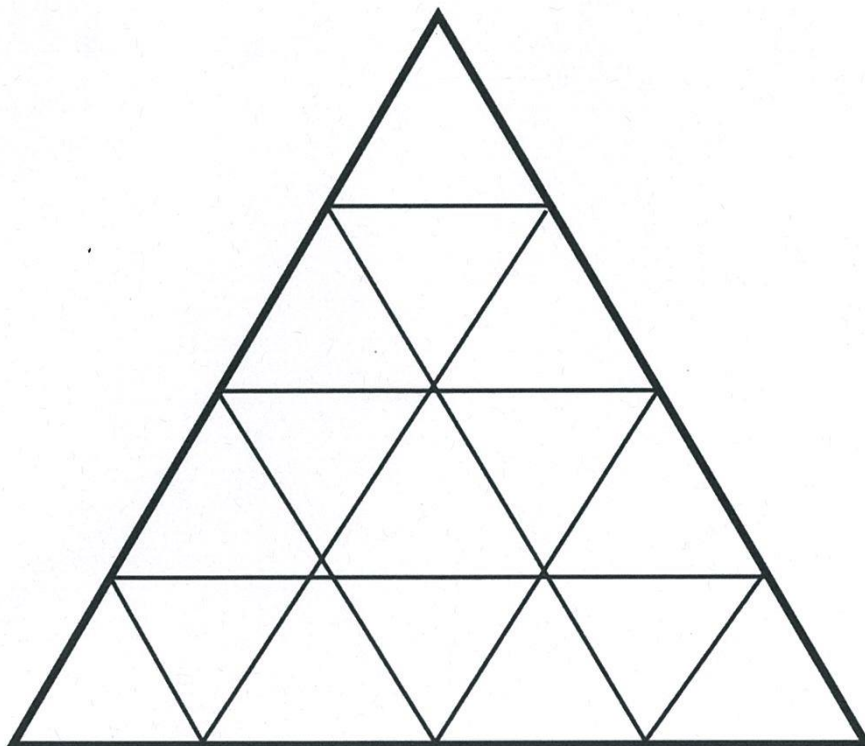

If the chicken and the corn are left together, the chicken will eat the corn.

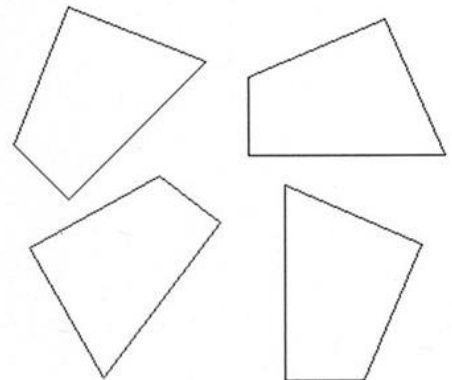

Children are **NOT** to bring money with them to the program or on an excursion day.

How to book places

Step 1

For NEW families to My Family Lounge (MFL), click on the My Family Lounge banner found on the OSHC page within the Kingsbury Primary School Website and then click on the REGISTER button. You will then be taken through a registration process to create your My Family Lounge (MFL) account.

Step 2

Log into your My Family Lounge (MFL) account and tell us about you, your child and any additional details or contacts.

Step 3

Log in to either My Family Lounge on your computer or log into the My Family Lounge app on iPhone or Android. Select the 'Vacation Care' room on the Casual Booking Calendar and book on the day/s you require. All information about the day is provided on the casual booking calendar and on this sheet.

You're done! Confirmation of the booking will change the day from green to blue on the Casual Booking Calendar!

Please tick the days required on this form and return it to the program if you do not have access to My Family Lounge.
