Dear Parents & Families,

As we come closer to the end of the year, it is time for us to review our fees and charges for next year. The annual rise in fees is kept to a minimum and in line with CPI to ensure that OLW remains accessible for all families. Therefore, the **School Fee for 2019 will be \$1450 per family and the levy will be \$400 per child.** (\$50.00 will be refunded if families attend one working bee during the year)

*If you ever have any concerns with the school fees or payments, please let the office know so that we can assist you with managing your situation.*

Orders can still be made with Red Door for families wishing to use their service on those Wednesday's.

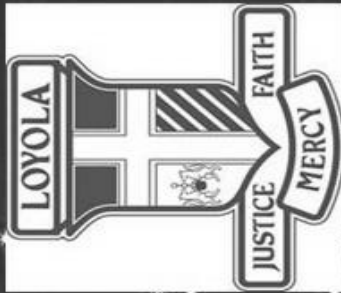
