And, in the words of Karl Rahner, when we ask where our dead have gone, we know that: " They have gone to be with God, the God of Abraham and Isaac and Jacob, not the God of the dead but of the living. So the calm we eventually experience, when our necessary period of mourning is done, is not a sign that things are again as they were before; that cannot be. It is rather a sign that part of us lives now, already in eternity, with our loved living dead." – Karl Rahner, Encounters with Silence (St Augustine's Press 1999).

So let us remember with love our now silent friends – those women and men who went before us marked with the sign of faith, who blessed us by their presence in the ordinariness of our lives. Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord. And may perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.
