Dear Parents & Families,

As you would have read in last week's newsletter, in 2019 we are introducing a specialist program called 'Futurescapes' in which over time we hope to involve a range of activities across many areas of the curriculum. To have the space to run the program, it is necessary to move some of our learning spaces around. This will mean that many of our classes will be moving. To facilitate this move, the Year 4/5 and 5/6 classes will initially be moving into the allowing the Library Futurescapes program to be set up in their current learning space. This space will then become known as the 'Imaginarium'. The current Library space will then be divided and become the Prep and Year 1 classrooms and Years 1/2 to 4/5 will be in the other 4 rooms in the main building whilst Year 6 will take up the current Year 3/4 classroom. The move is planned to start next week.

They investigate also mechanical principles while building real machines; build, program and modify a robot; and use LEGO bricks to create, write and visualise a story and publish it

electronically. It will be great day of fun and learning!
