EDUCATION BOARD

Our Ed Board has considered some options for additional lunch order providers and I am pleased to announce that we will be commencing a trial with Classroom Cuisine each Wednesday from November 14 to December 19.

To use this service, all you have to do is register your child's details online with class and school. Classroom Cuisine already have our classes in their system so the process is quite simple. Orders can be placed and paid for online any time (even ahead of time) up until 8.30am on the day, and they can also be cancelled if your child is ill. The range of food choices is excellent, so please have a look through the attached menu and web address. As this is a trial, we will need your support in using the service if you would like to have this as an option in 2019.

Although there are drinks options on the menu, OLW is a water only school. If students have other drinks, they are placed in the fridge and given to them at the end of the day. Orders can still be made with Red Door for families wishing to use their service on those Wednesday's.

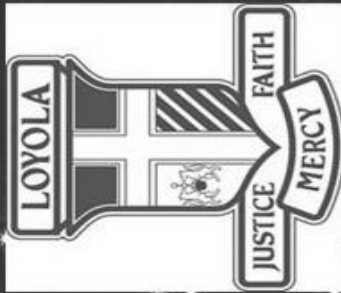
