This is a pilgrim post from ARCHBISHOP PETER A COMENSOLI. The ring of a doorbell or the knock on the door is an invitation. Do you answer it? Is it someone unanticipated? Have you been waiting eagerly? For it? Especially when it is an expected ring or knock, you really want to be able hear it. So, listening is always the first thing needed when that expected person comes calling at your door. Listening is the first action JESUS invited us to adopt in our lives. WHY? Because "I am standing at the door knocking". This is JESUS's way of welcome and his promise: to always be at the door of our hearts, eagerly knocking. JESUS is inviting us right now to listen out for his knock. It is a knock of a friend, wanting to sit down with us, and to share his life with us-me with you and you with me. So our deepest need is one of stopping and listening. So that we might know when to open that door to our crucified and risen friend. The Catholic Church in Australia, God's pilgrim people in this ancient land has begun a journey of discovery into what GOD is calling us to be at this time. This journey over several years is called a PLENARY COUNCIL. That is simply a formal title for listening, discerning, deciding, and acting together. GOD with us and us with GOD. Its purpose is to discover how we might best live a life of GOSPEL discipleship in our Australian context today and tomorrow. To be continued.

My thought is, if you sit in silent you can listen. The letters in listen turn them around and they spell silent.
