## CSEF - CAMPS, SPORTS AND EXCURIONS FUND

CSEF will be provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card you may be eligible for CSEF. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is \$125 for primary school students.

## **FIRE Carriers News**

On Friday 15th March Adele, Eva, Dominga and Charlotte our 2019 FIRE Carriers spent the day at an Aboriginal cultural immersion experience at Melbourne Museum, attending the 'Bunjilaka' Exhibition. We had a guided tour with indigenous leaders. 'FIRE Carriers' is an acronym for Friends Igniting Reconciliation through Education. It is an initiative through the Catholic Aboriginal Ministry of Victoria.

Through this program the FIRE Carriers are commissioned to raise awareness of reconciliation for the wrongs of the past and promote peace and justice for all, along with learning about and appreciating the the rich culture of the Aboriginal peoples.

Below is a statement of one of the things the students learnt on this day.


'I learnt that the Aboriginals made their own seasons in Victoria. They had 7 different seasons.' Eva

'The Aboriginals used possum skins to keep them warm.' Adele

'I learnt about all the different types of plants they would eat in the Milarri Gardens.' Charlotte

'I learnt that Aboriginal people paint their face white when they are mourning.' Dominga

With our new understanding the F.I.R.E Carrier leaders are going to lead the school to share their knowledge and build reconciliation for all. They have pledged to rebuild 'Bunjil's Nest' as one of the experience on the day was learning about 'Bunjil' the eagle and sitting in his nest.
