Dear Parents & Families,

Last Wednesday our school system went live with Care Monkey to manage student medical information, excursion forms and sports permission forms. Care Monkey uses email as the main way to communicate with you. Each main family contact has been sent an email invitation asking you to create your account and a profile for your child/ren.

At this stage, only 4 out of 172 students have a profile created by their parents. After creating your child's profile, you will receive notification of upcoming excursions or sports activities and only have to approve their participation and medical information, rather than re-enter the details repeatedly on paper forms. You can also change the language setting to complete the information in your preferred language.

If you can't find the email invitation you should check the junk and spam folders in your email account. An email reminder has been sent every 2 days since last Wednesday!

Reflection:

By virtue of our Baptism. All Christians are called to holiness of life. This means living out our baptismal promises in the midst of the world and, in the words of Vatican 2, “renewing the temporal order.”

That renewal will only come from supernatural grace. Blessed John Henry Newman, “soon to be saint, raised to Sainthood by Pope Francis this month.”

“We attain to heaven by using the world well, though it is too pass away, we perfect our nature, not by undoing it, but by adding to it what is more than nature and directing it to ends higher than its own.”

Newman puts first things first, allowing the light of faith to illuminate this world as good yet fallen, as coming from the hand of God, but needing cleansing in the blood of his only son, Jesus Christ. In this way, the smallest detail of our daily lives can, in the words of Henry David Thoreau, become, ‘lurking places’ for the divine.

Traditionally, Catholics have set aside each day for a special remembrance of some aspect of the Faith. For instance, Sunday is unique in the endless rounds of weeks and years as it is the Lords Day, the morning of his resurrection.
