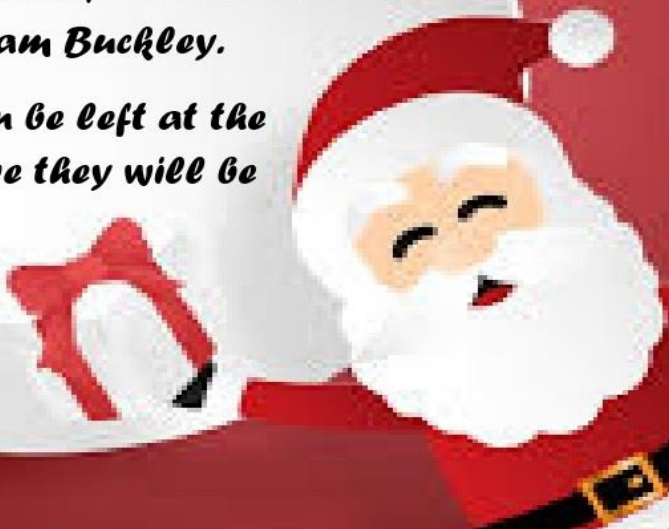
This week's Junior Leader is Coca for being a great helper in our cooking activities. Well done, Coca!
