

Each event started with a minimum of 17 competitors from all around the state, and they competed until a final top 8 was achieved for the final. Both boys made it to the final in their event. William Brierty finished 4th in the 11 year old discus competition final with only 20cm separating 2nd, 3rd and 4th. William Nakonesky won the 10 year old triple jump competition, jumping a personal best of 9.29m to become the State Champion. It was an amazing effort by both our Wills’.
