Our Junior Leader this week is Charlize for her excellent manners and positive attitude. Well done, Charlize!

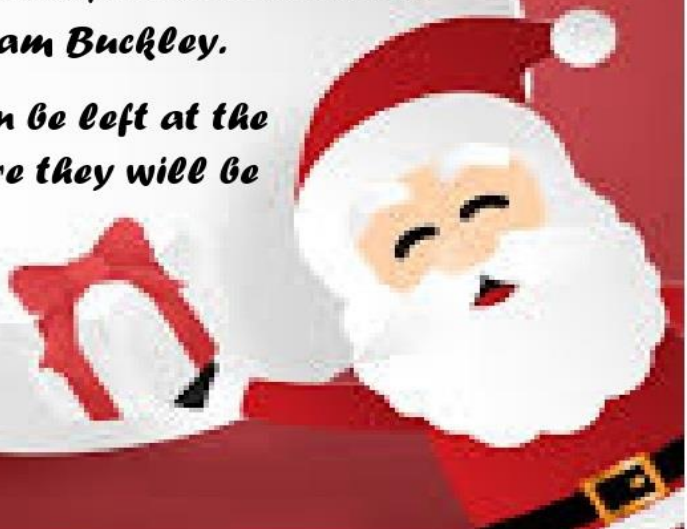
