

**Dear Parents & Families,** 

Thank you to everyone for their work with their children over the past week, especially those who have been dealing with power outages and internet issues. In spite of these difficulties for some families, it has been great to see the continued development of the children whilst Learning from Home.

Class teachers have commenced making contact with families by phone this week on the day they are scheduled for onsite supervision. In this way, all families should be contacted over an approximate two-week period. The purpose of this first call is just to touch base with families and give a little feedback on their child's performance. Our feedback from families has been extremely positive, and this can be seen in the many pictures that have been sent in each week. Please keep the pictures coming in by email to me or your class teacher as they are a great inspiration to both the staff and school families.

Our OLW Learning Channel on YouTube continues to develop as Miss Nguyen, Miss Kent and Miss Penzo continue to work behind the scenes creating instructional and practice videos focussing on the M100+ words, 2 - 5 syllable words and various digraphs. Access to the channel and activities will appear on your child's weekly schedule as appropriate to your child's class program and is a great way for the students to continue practising at home. Over the course of the term, more items will be added to the channel to support learning.

Students on PLP's or Intervention Programs were contacted by Mrs Luff last week as we continue to modify their learning based on their PLP or program. Access to modified resources with login information has also been arranged for these students and details were emailed to those families concerned.

As some families grapple with unprecedented changes to emotional wellbeing finances, and physical health, we have taken a clear position on supporting these families, just as we have supported families experiencing difficulty in the past. Formal contact about school fees will be made with families later in Term 2, but we do ask that families who can afford to pay their school fees, continue to do so as usual.
