Thank you to everyone for their continued work with their children at home over the past week. Our overall school application and performance has been outstanding, with our students successfully answering just over 390,00 questions over the past 18 days of Learning from Home!

Class teachers have been making contact with families by phone over the past two weeks on the day they are scheduled for onsite supervision and will continue to do so throughout the term. The purpose of the call is to touch base regularly with families and give a little feedback on their child's performance. Please remember that your child's class teacher is also available online daily between 9.00am and 3.30pm, with the details on the front of their weekly schedule. They will be happy to assist you with any questions about your child's learning.
