Dear Parents & Families,

Thank you to everyone who supported our Book Week Dress Up Day last Thursday. It was great to see so many students dress up in their favourite book character or in the theme of Book Week, being a curios creature or wild mind. We had many smiling faces as the students entered the school, especially when the students saw some of the staff costumes! Thank you to everyone for making it such a great day.

Work on our Refurbishment Project is well underway with the demolition and removal of materials from the stage 1 area. Remedial work will continue over the next couple of weeks as underpinning and replacement of the corridor roof occurs. Each week we will try to include some photos in the newsletter so that we can keep families updated with the progress.

The structuring and staging of our works for Stage 2 involving the refurbishment and replacement of the students' toilets has involved much discussion with the builders in order to have the least possible disruption to learning. After much discussion, and with Catholic Education approval, we are now bringing forward our finishing date at the end of the year to Friday December 11. It had previously been Wednesday December 16. By finishing school 3 days earlier, this will allow for the demolition of the current toilets and then allow them to be rebuilt prior to the Christmas break. Toilet partitions and amenities will then be installed prior to the commencement of the 2021 school year. This will allow us to start next year without disruption. We know this may be an inconvenience for some families, so we are negotiating with OSH Care to try to offer a service to families who need assistance with care for their child for those 3 days.

Revised school fee accounts were sent out to families last week. Each family has received a credit for the excursion and working bee levy for each child, and Years Prep – 2 who have not attended swimming in 2020 have also received a credit for that levy.

Please note that the credit to the school fee account may not always directly correspond to the bill item, however the total credit amount to your account is accurate. If you had previously settled your account for 2020, then your account will be in credit for 2021. This is shown at the bottom of the statement and the amount you are in credit will be in brackets and appear as shown below.

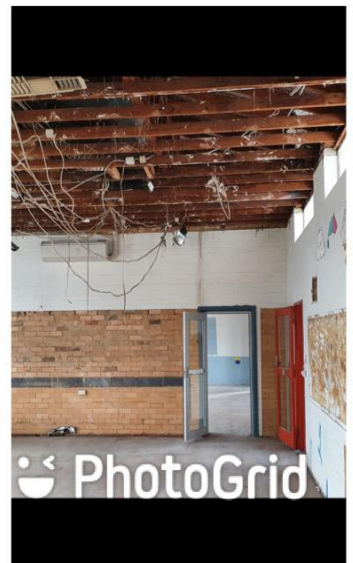
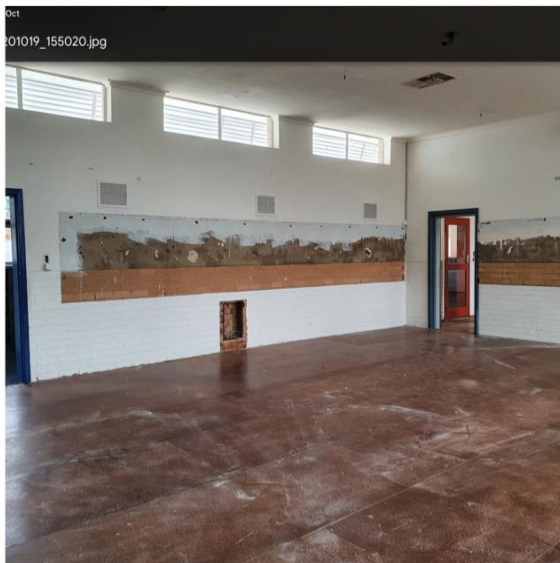
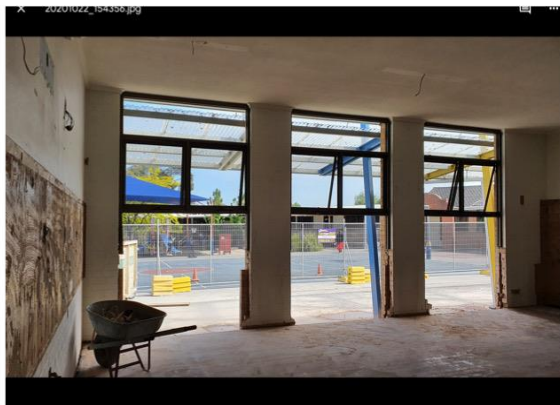
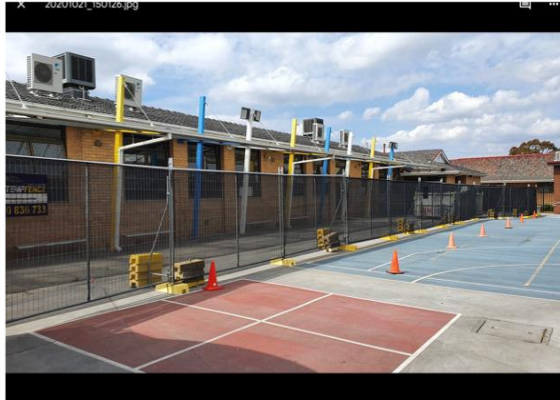
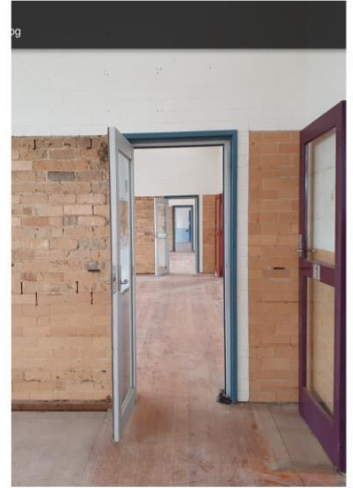
As we begin to emerge from the lock down, remember all people of faith, longing to see each other again and enjoy each other's company, and above all, worship together.

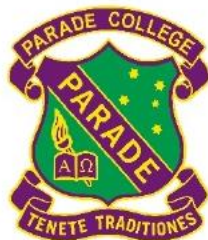
