Dear Parents & Families,

Welcome back to the start of the 2021 school year!

Work has been progressing at a rapid rate over the Christmas break, with the refurbishment of our school toilets now complete. Our classrooms are almost complete as of today, but work on our decking, ramp and handrails are still awaiting completion and approval. As a result, we will not be able to take possession of the classrooms until the necessary approvals have been given. Therefore, some classes will remain relocated for the first couple of weeks of term. Year 1/2S (Mrs Schroeder) will be using the Italian Room, Year 3/4K (Miss Kent) & Year 3/4L (Mrs Lavcock) will remain in the Hall, and Year 5/6EJ (Mrs Driscoll & Mrs Mithen) will use the Art Room (Monday - Wednesday) and the Library (Thursday & Friday). It will be a slight inconvenience, but well worth the wait!

#### **COVID-19 PROTOCOLS**

Schools have a new set of protocols for the commencement of the 2021 school year. There have been some minor modifications to protocols for schools in the latest government advice which now allow parents on site provided that we comply with the 1 person per 2m² indoors and that if you are onsite for more than 15 minutes, then you must register through our school QR code. The reality of this means that parents can enter the yard and bag area, but won't be able to enter the classrooms until the 2m² is lifted.

Schools are also still required to reduce congestion at drop-off and collection times. Therefore, as we only have one entry gate, we will remain with the staggered entry and exit times to avoid congestion at the gate and in the carpark area until further notice. Parents are still required to wear a mask if the 1.5m social distancing protocol cannot be adhered to. Drop off and pick up times are as follows:

The annual rise in fees is kept to a minimum and in line with, or just below CPI, to ensure that OLW remains accessible for all families.

As we informed you year, Student Book Orders will also be billed to your 2021 account as we will be ordering and receiving these items at the school. You will not be required to order and books or texts.

## **BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL CARE**

If your child is attending the Before and/or After School Care Program, please notify the school Office as soon as possible. Parents who use the Kingsbury staff car park must enter and exit the carpark slowly and safely - being mindful of students who may be around and other cars in the carpark.
