Dear Parents & Families,

Our Open Evening last Wednesday was very well attended by prospective families who were very impressed by what our school has to offer and the building works that have been completed. They were also very impressed with our School Captains who did an outstanding job leading the tours.

BUILDING WORK

Foundations for the structural work to begin building our veranda portal frame have now been completed and internal works to modify and refurbish our kitchen, toilets and Brennan Room are well underway with plumbing, electrical and plaster work completed over the past week. All overhead services have also been removed and will now run underground, providing easier and clearer access through the school gates.

DISTRICT ATHLETICS TRIALS

Congratulations to all the students who represented OLW in the Keon Park District Athletics last Friday. Our students performed exceptionally well on the day with many now going through to the Division Championships later in the year. Despite only taking a small and select group of athletes, our school finished 1st overall in an outstanding display of skill, teamwork and sportsmanship. Thank you to Mrs Van Ballegooy for all her work in preparing the team, the staff who assisted on the day, and the parents who came to support us.

PARENT - TEACHER INTEVIEWS

Parent – Teacher Interviews will be held on Monday April 26 due to Term 1 being such a short term. This will be a Closure Day for students, but the students will be required to attend the interview.

After discussion with the School Education Board, we are going to trial a mixed mode of presentation for the interviews. From 9.00am-12:30pm parents will be to access the school for an onsite interview for those who would like to meet in person with the teacher. From 2.00pm - 7.00pm, interviews will be held online to cater for those families who are working from home

or unable to make it to the school. A link will be provided to access the online meeting in the same way as online interviews were held in 2020. We hope that by trialling mixed modes for interviews that it will give more parents the opportunity to be actively involved in their child's learning discussions.


