### Dear Parents & Families,

# **PARENT - TEACHER INTEVIEWS**

Parent – Teacher Interviews will be held on Monday April 26. This will be a Closure Day for students, but the students will be required to attend the interview.

As explained in last week's newsletter, we are going to trial a mixed mode of presentation for the interviews. From 8.30am - 12:30pm parents will be to access the school for an onsite interview for those who would like to meet in person with the teacher. From 2.00pm - 7.00pm, interviews will be held online to cater for those families who are working from home, the office, or unable to make it to the school. A link will be provided to access the online meeting in the same way that online interviews were held in 2020. We hope by trialling mixed modes for interviews that it will give more parents the opportunity to be actively involved in their child's learning discussions.




# **Book School Interviews Online**

Parent-Teacher interviews on Monday April 26 from 9.00am – 7.00pm. Interviews will be held <u>ONSITE</u> at OLW between 8.30am – 12.30pm and <u>ONLINE</u> from 2.00pm – 7.00pm. Online interviews will be conducted once again using 'Whereby' and you will receive the instructions and video link in your booking confirmation email.

Bookings can be made through the School Interviews tab on our school app main page, or you can go to <a href="www.schoolinterviews.com.au">www.schoolinterviews.com.au</a> to enter the School Event code shown below.

Enter the school event code.

Then follow the 3 simple steps.









Before you click finish, make sure that you select 'email booking information' so that the link will be emailed to you automatically - check your junk mail folder if you do not receive your email immediately.

You can return to <a href="www.schoolinterviews.com.au">www.schoolinterviews.com.au</a> at any time, and change your interviews - until bookings close.

Interviews are strictly 15 minutes and spaces are limited on each day. If a teacher feels that the interview requires further discussion, they will make alternative arrangements with you.

Parents can change their interview bookings, any time prior to the closing date, by re-visiting the www.schoolinterviews.com.au website, and using the event code. Remember to use the same name and email address, you used when you made your original booking.

Where possible, we would prefer that the student also be involved in the discussion. However, we are aware that some parents may not be at home at the time of the interview, so having their child with them may not always be possible. If you are in this situation, please make sure that you speak with your child when you are at home and celebrate their successes.
