End of Year Reports will be sent home today. Please take the time to read through your child's report and celebrate their achievements. 2021 has brought challenges for everyone, but the learning and growth of our students has been outstanding. With your support, the students' engagement in Learning from Home was exceptional and this has shone through in our testing data showing that our students continue to perform at a very high level and well above the state averages, and this was supported in our NAPLAN data with our students achieving our best performance in NAPLAN since its inception!

2022 CLASSES

Year 1 – Year 6 students will spend a session with their 2022 class on Wednesday December 13. On this day the students will spend about an hour working with their new cohort and will also bring home booking information for the Beginning of Year Testing which will also be posted on our school app on Thursday.

2022 FAMILY & LEVY FEES

The School Fee for 2022 will be \$1750 per family and the levy will be \$400 per child. (\$50.00 will be refunded if families attend one working bee during the year). The annual rise in fees is kept to a minimum and in line with, or just below CPI, to ensure that OLW remains accessible for all families.

Student Book Orders will be managed by the school again this year. Families will not be required to order any classroom books or equipment for 2022. All books and requirements for your child will be billed to your 2022 school fee account. A list of any goods required to be brought from home will be sent home with your child after meeting their 2022 teacher on Wednesday.
