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Dear Parents & Families,

Our first week began very smoothly and our Preps have also settled in exceptionally well and are enjoying school life.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

There have been some further modifications to protocols for schools in the latest government advice which impacts on all schools.

Rapid Antigen Tests

All students that have attended school have now been provided with a pack of 5 tests. Students are required to test twice weekly (school days) on a voluntary basis. Students undertake the tests at home and must report any positive test results to their school. If a student receives a positive test result at any time, they must also report this through the Department of Health system (Rapid Antigen Tests Coronavirus Victoria) or via the coronavirus hotline at 1800 675 398.

Students who report a positive result must isolate for seven days and not attend school during that period.

Where a student is a *household contact* of a positive case (that is, they have spent more than four hours with someone who has COVID-19 inside a house, accommodation, or care facility) they *must inform the school and isolate for seven days and not attend school during that period.*

In the event of multiple positive cases at a school, the Department of Health (DH) will work with the relevant regional office to determine the most appropriate response and any additional actions that should be taken.

Managing Learning during Isolation

A major issue for schools will be lack of available staff during an outbreak. Therefore, a 5-day template of schoolwork will available for students to undertake at school if classes split at school.

A modified 5-day Learning from Home template available for students to undertake (voluntary) if isolating based on revision activities in Maths & English (IXL), online reading portals access, & an Inquiry / Research activity. The templates will be uploaded to our website this Wednesday, February 9, under the Learning from Home tab which can be accessed from the front page of the school website

Entry & Exit Restrictions

Access to the school site will still be limited to staff and students to minimize contact

with others. Staff will make themselves available to speak with any parents in a COVID-Safe manner. Our goal is to try and minimise disruption to student learning in 2022 by reducing as much personal contact as practical, especially as we currently have 2 staff unavailable due to COVID.

Schools are also still required to reduce congestion at drop-off and collection times. Drop off and pick up times are as follows:

FIRST EUCHARIST - YEAR 4 & 5

Miss Kent released an information <u>video</u> last Friday for families of children in Year 4 & 5 who will be celebrating their First Eucharist on either February 20 or 27. If your child tests positive to COVID and is unable to receive the Sacrament on their planned day, we will move them into the Year 3 group who will celebrate the Sacrament later in Term 2.

A family activity booklet was also sent home on Friday to assist the students in preparing for the Sacrament. If you have any further questions about the Sacrament, please contact the school office and a staff member will make contact you.

CONTACT & EMERGENCY DETAILS

If there is a change of address, mobile number, home, work phone number or email please notify the office so that our records can be updated. You must also make the change in Operoo so that all forms for school extracurricular activities reach the correct email address.

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL CARE

If your child is attending the Before and/or After School Care Program, please notify the school Office as soon as possible. We also keep a list of students who attend the Program, showing on what days of the week they attend. This reduces confusion and enables us to know where each child is after school.

BE SUNSMART – WEAR A HAT!

The School Hat must be worn during Term 1 and in Term 4. Children who do not have a school hat are required to sit under the veranda or on the deck at recess and Lunchtime.

MEDICATION REGISTER:

All schools are required by law to have a medication register book. When your child requires medication, we require a parent / guardian to fill out this book on what medication your child requires and when the medication is required. Medication must be in its original packaging and the dosage must be specified on the packet and confirmed by the parent in writing.

As a general rule, if your child requires medication for an illness, then they are not well enough to attend school.
