Our school will be using Compass for:

- 1. **Student Attendance** log absences, late arrivals, or early departures directly in the app.
- 2. School Communication Feed stay up to date with school news and notices.
- 3. Academic Results view and download your child's semester reports.

Please note: We will not be going live with Compass until the beginning of Term 4. Please do not start marking attendance or submitting absences in the app just yet.

For parents who would like help setting up the Compass app, we will be available in the school hall on Thursday 11th September from 2:30pm.


GEM+EL Chats


Benji PM What's happening in 5/6

COMMUNITY NEWS

Our team provides the school dental treatment team for families at your school. This service is completed every 6 months in keeping with the Australian Dental Association Guidelines.

Once we have agreed dates with your school, we will provide you with a consent form for completion and return to us.

We will check your Medicare account to ascertain your child's eligibility.

If your child is not eligible, you have the option to pay \$99.00 for the service. If you are paying for the service, you can claim this against your health insurance should you have such an arrangement.
